

NW Tour & Trail presents the **5th** annual Scaredy Cat Dualsport Ride!



All skill level of riders will enjoy this ride! It is an easy, dualsport ride for big bikes, small bikes, sidecars, and newbies or experienced riders, with an adventure-touring theme. We like to ride out in our forests and want to show everyone the spectacular views and beauty in the Detroit Lake area.

Sunday, September 13, 2009. Signup opens at 7AM and riders meeting at 8AM. The first riders are out, after the riders meeting.



The start/finish is at Fox Creek Group Campsite, Detroit, Oregon, about 6 miles from Hwy 22. The course will meander around Detroit Lake area (50 miles east of Salem) and back. Cost is only \$20 per pre-entry and \$25 the day of the event (post entry).

The main, easy course is approximately 140 miles long. There is an emergency gas option (110 miles). We are going to have a lunch checkpoint at Clear Lake Resort. There might be a pick-up, to haul your gas can, available. This will not be your typical dualsport event with just a rollchart. Map reading skills will also benefit you. You will have various options for ways to get you through the forest utilizing rollcharts. Think of this as a scavenger-hunt adventure! We will also have a shorter rollchart loop, that doesn't go to the lunch checkpoint.



- We will have some novel checkpoints that will make you think and a scavenger-hunt theme.
- Garmin GPS info will be posted on the Scaredy Cat page. Chance of Geo-cash/scavenger-hunt points.
- A lowball hand could also make a top-five finish.
- A percentage of the overall money will be awarded as a cash prize!
- Pre-entry will include GPS data (check points, scavenger-hunt clue spots, resets, etc.) to use on the ride. E-mail hatchetmandan@blackdogdualsport.com for info.
- Camping at Fox Creek Site is primitive. There are vault toilets and no running water (I will have a little extra water for bike campers), and camping is prepaid. For full hook-up camping, RV Mountain View Park is 15 minutes away at Idanha (5 minutes past Detroit on Hwy 22.) They have roomy, grass-covered tent sites, hot showers, and reasonable rates, too. - Directions to Fox Creek Group Campsite are: Take Hwy. 22 about 50 miles east of Salem to Detroit. Turn left, just after crossing the bridge, and go up the Breitenbush River (past the Marina). After traveling 6 ¼ miles from Hwy. 22, the camping spot is on the left. We will have signs on the road. Parking is level, wide-open gravel, with some tables, vault toilets, some shade trees, and easy access. Bring your own water.
